2013 was one of the warmest, driest years we have ever experienced in Southern Oregon, making the subsequent Petite Sirah harvest one of the ripest we have ever picked! A customer favorite, this vintage exhibits a tightly wound bouquet of blueberry and blackcurrant. The palate is medium-bodied, with succulent blackberry and blueberry fruit, and a powerful thread of acidity. Pure and well-balanced, it will age nicely over several years (assuming you can wait that long!).
